## Program Details

### Purpose, Lessons

Participants will travel extensively throughout the Lake Constance area and Switzerland. They are offered an opportunity to participate in optional German lessons (included in fees) suitable for learners from beginning to advanced levels.

### Accommodations and Meals

Participants are housed in efficiency apartments in a dormitory of the University of Konstanz; bedding is provided. They may prepare their meals in the kitchen of their apartment or eat in one of the many local restaurants of all price ranges.

### Prerequisites

The Program is open to anyone over 18 years of age. No previous knowledge of German is necessary. Permission of the Director is required.

### Fees

\$1,645.00 (\$1,695 after February 1, 2017)  
Included are all Program expenses, housing, excursions, and language instruction. Airfare and meals are not included.

As in previous years, Prof. Peter J. Schroeck will conduct a three-week travel/study Program in Konstanz, Germany. The Program invites participants to enjoy the Lake Constance area and offers them an opportunity to improve their German language skills in a German-speaking environment. Lake Constance, bordered by Austria, Germany, and Switzerland, is recognized internationally for its picturesque scenery and cultural treasures. This setting provides an ideal atmosphere for travel, recreation and relaxation, as well as for study.

Day trips from Konstanz include Munich, the Black Forest, Meersburg, the Flower Island of Mainau, UNESCO World Heritage Reichenau Island (Germany), St. Gall, Zurich, Stein-am-Rhein, the Rhine Falls at Schaffhausen (Switzerland), and Strasbourg (France).

Total immersion provides students with an opportunity to practice German in everyday situations. Participants are also encouraged to attend the numerous festivals of this resort area and to interact with native speakers.
